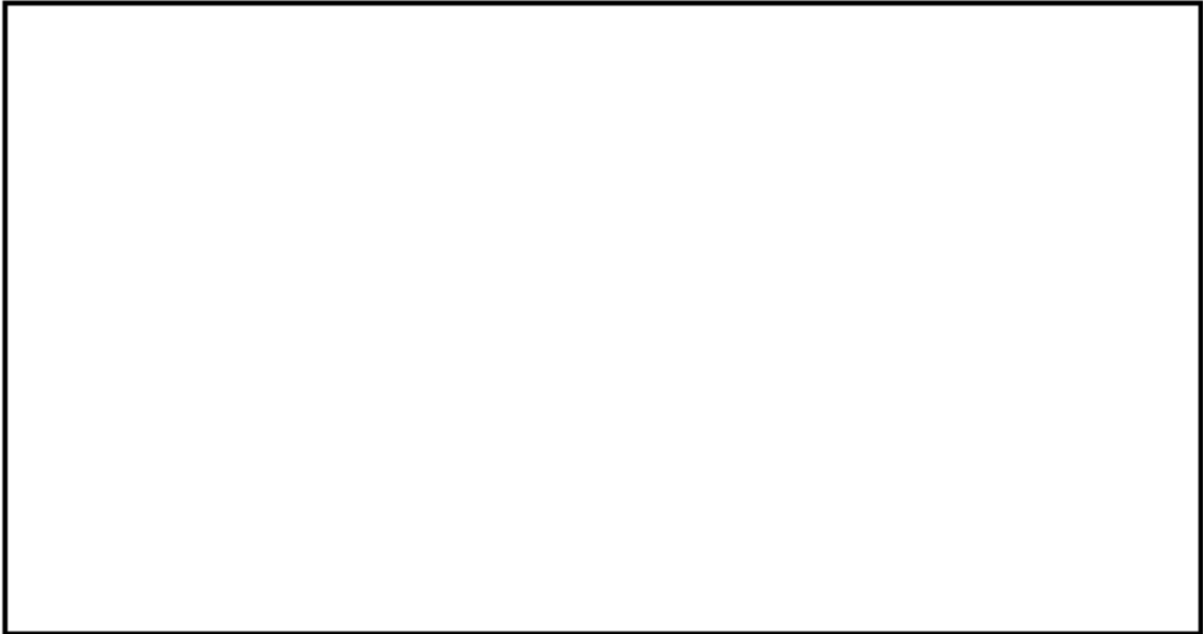
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2. List 4 different types of physical features of China that you saw in the video so far. (Physical features are what the land looked like, e.g lakes, forests)
